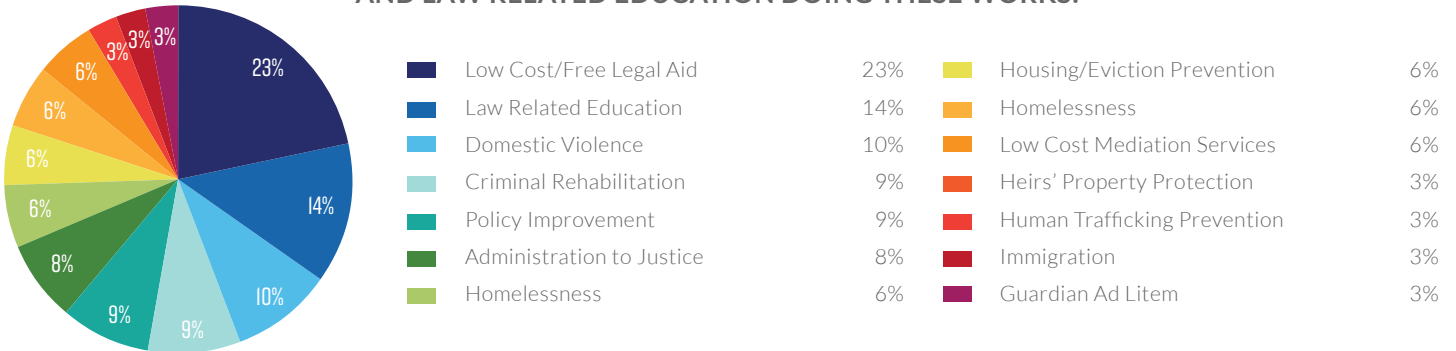

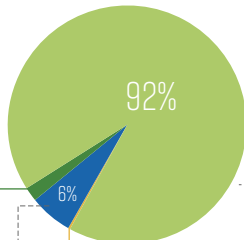

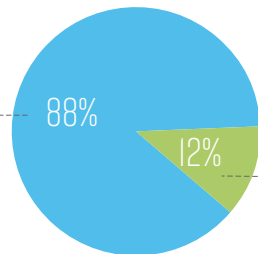
"We have been extremely grateful for the SC Bar Foundation grant. It has allowed us to assist individuals pay for the court costs or administrative fees that had the potential to entangle them in the criminal legal system indefinitely. Costs that seem straightforward or simple, for example the \$100 reinstatement fee for the Department of Motor Vehicles, are less straightforward when they are buried under complex and powerful systems. Getting one's license back is more than just getting on the road - it allows someone to expand the geographic scope of their job and housing opportunities. Being given the choice between pretrial intervention and a time-served plea is not really a choice if you cannot afford the program fees. The SC Bar Foundation grant has allowed us to remove finances from decisions like this; it has allowed us to chip away at the hurdle of economic inequity that stands between a person and their opportunities."
